Since February 2002, at least 400,000 people are estimated to have died in Darfur as a result of what the President and Congress recognized in 2004 to be genocide, with 3.5 million dependent on foreign aid for their survival and 2.5 million forced by violence to live in make-shift camps.

A campaign of terror, violence and mass rape continues every day, leaving fathers and sons in fear for their lives, wives and daughters in fear for their bodies.

Brian Steidle, a former US Marine captain, served as American observer to the African Union peacekeeping mission in Darfur. Capt. Steidle will speak as an eyewitness to mass murder, rape and other atrocities in Darfur. In his national tour, Capt. Steidle will travel over 21,000 miles in an effort to raise awareness on genocide in Darfur and promote simple actions that individual Americans can take to help make a difference.
